<b>Facility Info</b>	The Neptune Aquatic Center is a new, state of the art, 8-lane 25 yard facility with Colorado timing and Keifer-McNeil lane lines. The depth of the pool at the starting end is 10' and the depth at the turning end is 5'. There is ample on-deck seating for swimmers and a gallery for spectators. There will be two additional lanes available for warm-up/cool-down throughout the meet.
<b>Pool Certification Statement</b>	The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Note that this statement is a required meet announcement statement, and refers to the pre-certification of the pool length measurement in regards to National and World Record swims which may occur in the pool. The fact that this pool is not certified in accordance to 104.2.2C(4) does not impact on the validity of the times achieved in this pool. Times swum at this meet will in fact be entered in SWIMS and are eligible for qualifying for any other USA Swimming sanctioned competition.

<b>Entry Deadline</b>	<p><b>Entry Deadline: Wednesday February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2015</b>  <b>E-Mail entry file and proof of time report to: <a href="mailto:entries1@juno.com">entries1@juno.com</a>.</b>            There will be no refunds after the entry deadline except for events that may be scratched from meet by the Entry Coordinator or Meet Director, or as otherwise required by NJ Swimming. Entries will be acknowledged within 48 hours of receipt.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All entries will be accepted up until the entry deadline. As a NJS Championship designated meet, the 4 hour per session rule does not pertain to this meet.</li> <li>• <b>Mail the signed waiver and entry fee check to:</b> Be Smartt, Inc, 604 Paxson Avenue, Mercerville, NJ 08619</li> <li>• <b>Entry forms, verification forms, waiver release, and fees must be received no later than the first session of the meet where the team competes.</b></li> <li>• Team entries will be considered accepted when the host club accepts the entries.</li> <li>• It is not necessary to use overnight or express mail to send hard copy and check, which are sent in support of an e-mailed entry.</li> </ul>
<b>Meet Format Waiver</b>	<p>The host club has the right to change the format of the meet with the approval of the sanctioning chairman and either the age group or senior chairman. These changes would be made for a more efficient swim meet for the swimmers and the host club. Reasons for these changes include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To allow more swimmers to swim.</li> <li>• To conform to facility capacity limits or for facility safety concerns.</li> <li>• To condense the meet into smaller time frame.</li> </ul> <p>Some of the changes that can be made: 1) add a session 2) heat limit distance events 3) condense sessions and 4) eliminate relays.</p>

<b>Meet Requirement Statement</b>	In order to be eligible for the New Jersey Swimming Zone Championship Team or for NJ Swimming Athlete Travel Grants for sectional and national level meets, NJ Swimming policy stipulates certain participation requirements. As a New Jersey Swimming sanctioned meet, this meet counts towards those participation requirements.
<b>Coaches Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All coaches “on the deck” must be current coach members of USA Swimming.</li> <li>• All coaches must have coaching cards visible at all times.</li> </ul>
<b>Swimmer Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All swimmers must be members of USA Swimming to enter and compete in this meet.</li> <li>• All swimmers must be listed on a team’s official entry form to be eligible to participate in this swim meet in any event(s), including relays.</li> <li>• This is a New Jersey Swimming Championship Meet; only New Jersey Swimming registered athletes may enter and compete in this meet.</li> <li>• All transfer swimmer(s) must swim unattached for 120 days from their last attached competition. Swimmers must use an UN- (New Team Alpha Code) as their team affiliation. All Unattached swimmers must be listed on the team’s official waiver entry form.</li> <li>• There will be 8 year old, 7 year old, 8-under, 7-under, and 6-under events offered.</li> <li>• There are no time standards being used in this meet.</li> <li>• Swimmers are permitted to compete in a maximum of <b>5</b> events, with a maximum of <b>4</b> being individual events.</li> <li>• Age for this meet is as of <b>March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015</b></li> <li>• Qualifying times for this meet must have been achieved since January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014.</li> </ul>
<b>USA-S Racing Start Certification Statement</b>	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
<b>USA-S Deck Change Policy Statement</b>	Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.
<b>Meet Format</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This meet will be run in accordance to current USA Swimming Rules.</li> <li>• This meet will be deck seeded with coaches checking in/scratching all swimmers.</li> <li>• Swimmers will report to the marshalling area for organizing heats and lanes and escorted to the pool.</li> </ul>
<b>Meet Schedule</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The building will open at 6:50am.</li> <li>• This meet will have two sessions.</li> <li>• The afternoon session starting time will be announced once entries are received and a time line is established.</li> </ul>

<b>Warm-up Procedures</b>	<p>Warm-ups will be run under New Jersey Swimming Warm-up and Safety Guidelines. Teams will be assigned lanes for warm-ups. When more than two teams share a common lane for warm-ups, all teams must agree to a warm-up procedure. If clubs sharing a lane can't agree on a warm-up procedure, that lane will be a general warm-up lane.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All swimmers are entitled to a fair and comparable warm-up. All teams <b>MUST</b> get the same opportunities for general warm-up lanes, sprint lanes, and pace lanes.</li> <li>• All swimmers must enter the pool from the starting end of the pool.</li> <li>• All swimmers must enter feet first.</li> <li>• New Jersey Swimming officials will monitor warm-ups.</li> <li>• All general warm-up lanes will swim in a counterclockwise direction.</li> <li>• There will be a one-hour warm-up session with sprint lanes offered in the final 15 minutes</li> <li>• The warm-up sessions will likely be three 15-minute warm-ups divided by teams, and then a 15 minute period of one way sprints for all swimmers in the session.</li> <li>• Exact warm-up details will be emailed to participating teams 1 week prior to the meet.</li> </ul>
<b>Entry Times</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New Jersey Swimming does not allow 'NT' or 'No Time' to be used as an entry time.</li> <li>• All entry times must be in short course yards.</li> <li>• <b>For all New Jersey Swimming Championship Meets, proof of time must be included with all entries. Entries without proof of time will not be accepted into any New Jersey Swimming Championship Meet. (See "Proof of Times Reporting" section below.)</b></li> </ul>
<b>Proof of Times Reporting</b>	The TM entries report with the <i>Include Proof of Time</i> option selected will suffice. This report should be saved as a PDF file and the file emailed to the entry coordinator along with the entry file.
<b>Check-In</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All check-in sheets must be turned in 30 minutes before the start of each session. Swimmers that are swimming will have a line through their name. Swimmers that are being scratched will have their names circled with a "SCR" next to the circle. Swimmers scratching a single event will have a line through his/her name and the event number circled with "SCR" next to the circle. Failure to follow these procedures may result in the swimmer(s) being scratched from the session.</li> </ul>
<b>Starts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 'Fly-over' or 'Over-the-top' will be determined prior to the meet.</li> </ul>
<b>Relays</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All relays <b>MUST HAVE THE CORRECT FOUR NAMES LISTED AND THE CORRECT</b> order for that relay to be eligible.</li> <li>• Coaches must turn in relay cards prior to that relay swimming, listing correct swimmers names and correct order.</li> <li>• The host club will be responsible for obtaining the correct names and correct order at the starting block.</li> </ul>
<b>Scoring</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Team Scoring will not be kept.</li> </ul>
<b>Awards</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medals will be awarded to the top 8 swimmers in each individual event and the top 3 relay teams in relay events.</li> </ul>
<b>Entry Fees</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individual Entry Fee: \$5.00</li> <li>• Relay Entry Fee: \$8.00</li> <li>• Make checks payable to: <b>MONMOUTH BARRACUDAS</b></li> <li>• Host club has the right to scratch teams/swimmers for lack of payment of entry fees.</li> </ul>
<b>Admissions and Programs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Admission will be \$6.00 for the entire meet.</li> <li>• Cost of Program will be \$5.00 for the entire meet.</li> </ul>



<b>Entries</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In accordance with NJS policy, team entries may be submitted by E-mail to <a href="mailto:entries1@juno.com">entries1@juno.com</a></li> <li>• All entries must be Hy-Tek program entries as an attached file to an e-mail.</li> <li>• <b>All entries must be accompanied by a copy of the TM Meet Entries report with the <i>Proof of Time</i> option enabled in PDF format.</b></li> <li>• The meet entry coordinator will respond to e-mails entries within 48 hours. If you do not receive an e-mail response within 48 hours, assume that your email has not been received. It then becomes the e-mailer's responsibility to make sure that the host club's meet entry coordinator receives the e-mail. If you do not receive an e-mail response, you must contact the entry coordinator by email or phone.</li> <li>• An Entry Summary with a signed NJ Swimming waiver and a check must accompany or follow each entry.</li> <li>• Accuracy of seed times is essential. Incomplete entries will not be accepted.</li> <li>• Deck entries will not be accepted. No phone or faxed entries will be accepted.</li> </ul>
<b>Results</b>	Meet results will be emailed to all participating teams.
<b>Host Club Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The host club will provide a single timer in each lane throughout the meet.</li> <li>• The host club will have stopwatches available for volunteers helping to time.</li> <li>• The host club will e-mail all club entries back to the participating clubs.</li> <li>• The host club will create a warm-up schedule that will be fair and equal to all teams. This warm-up schedule will be e-mailed to all participating clubs. The host club will create timing assignments that are fair and equitable with as many teams participating as possible. These timing assignments will be e-mailed to all participating clubs at least 1 week prior to the meet.</li> </ul>
<b>Participating Club Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participating clubs must help with timing assignments. Timing assignments will be e-mailed to participating clubs and posted on the swim meet website: <a href="http://www.besmartin.com">www.besmartin.com</a> 1 week prior to the meet.</li> <li>• Participating club parents must stay off the pool deck except for timing assignments.</li> <li>• Participating clubs should help with officiating whenever possible. List the club contact for club officials on the meet summary.</li> </ul>
<b>Concessions</b>	Food Concessions will be available in the Lobby,
<b>Vendor</b>	A sports vendor will be selling merchandise at the meet.

Make a left turn onto Neptune Boulevard. Neptune High School is on the left, just past the township municipal building. ### Article 302.4 of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations
