Location	Neptune Aquatic Center, 55 Neptune Blvd, Neptune NJ – Accessible from Heck Ave. Championship bussing and parking maps available at the end of packet.			
Entrances and Spectator Information	Swimmers, coaches, officials: Should enter through the back doors off of Flier Drive. (See bussing maps) Busses will be directed to the drop off area and swimmers will enter through these doors and check in.			
	<i>Spectators</i> : Should enter though the Aquatic Center main glass doors and through the lobby. The cost for the event will be \$5 per entry and tickets will be restricted. As of October 2021, Spectator entrance is still to be determined and we may have to move to a spectator free meet based on state and local guidelines. In both instances, the meet will be livestreamed.			
Entrance Fees and Program Fees	Shore Conference will be charging \$5.00 per entry. Programs (psych sheets) will be available at the meet for \$2.00 and also posted on Meet Mobile.			
Parking Information	Parking will be available in the Neptune Aquatic Center Lot, Neptune Board office and Neptune Middle School lots as well as street parking. Parking is of no charge.			
Bus Parking	Busses will drop swimmers off at the championship entrance (see bussing map) and then proceed to directed bus parking either lined up on flier drive or across the street at 60 Neptune Blvd.			
Facility Info	The Neptune Aquatic Center is an 8 lane competitive facility with 2 warm up cool down lanes as well as Colorado championship timing. The upstairs is bleacher seating only and no deck chairs will be allowed. We are fully accessible on both levels.

If you do not have the team manager software, please download this to use. Then, import the Shore Conference Meet File from the <a href="http://www.NeptuneSchools.org">www.NeptuneSchools.org</a> website or <a href="http://www.besmarttinc.com">www.besmarttinc.com</a> . Entries must include the swimmers best time in yards from the 2021-2022 seasons. Relay entries must include four possible swimmers. Names may be changed up to 1/2 hour prior to the meet start at timing podium. No other events may be changed. After Psych sheets are released, no swimmers will be moved to a different event and times will not be adjusted to be faster than the original entry.  If your swimmer wants their times to help them qualify for a sectional cut time, you MUST enter their swimmer ID number correctly into the entry submission.
