The host club must stay within the four hour per session rule.
<u>Meet Format Waiver:</u>	<p>The host club has the right to change the format of the meet with the approval of the sanctioning chairman and age group or senior chairman. These changes would be made for a more efficient swim meet for the swimmers and the host club. Reasons for these changes include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To allow more swimmers to swim. • To conform to facility capacity limits or for facility safety concerns. • To condense the meet into smaller time frame. <p>Some of the changes that can be made: 1) add a session, 2) heat limit distance events, 3) to condense sessions.</p>

<p><u>Meet Requirement Statement:</u></p>	<p>In order to be eligible for the SC New Jersey Zone Championship Team or for NJ Swimming Athlete Reimbursement for sectional and national level meets, NJ Swimming policy stipulates certain participation requirements. As a NJ Swimming sanctioned meet, this meet counts towards those participation requirements.</p>
<p><u>Coaches Eligibility:</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All coaches “on the deck” must be members of USA Swimming. • Coaches must have coaching card visible at all times while on deck.
<p><u>Swimmer Eligibility:</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All swimmers must be members of USA Swimming to enter and compete in this meet. • All swimmers must be listed on a team’s official entry form to be eligible to participate in this swim meet in any events including relays. • All transfer swimmer(s) must swim unattached for 120 days from their last attached competition. Swimmers must use an UN- (New Team Alpha Code) as their team affiliation. All Unattached swimmers must be listed on the team’s official waiver entry form. • Swimmers who have one or two silver or faster qualifying times can enter/swim three events. • There will be 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, and 15-18 Events. • New Jersey Swimming only allows swimmers to compete in 3 individual events per day. • Age for this meet is: Sunday, January 29th, 2012
<p><u>Swimmers Unaccompanied by a USAS Certified Coach:</u></p>	<p>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. If a swimmer is not accompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, then it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</p>
<p><u>Meet Format:</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This meet will be run in accordance to current USA Swimming Rules. • This meet will be run as a time final meet. • This meet will be deck seeded with coaches checking in/scratching all swimmers. Swimmers will report to the marshalling area for organizing heats and lanes and escorted to the pool. • Swimmers will have access to the adjoining gym for marshalling and for waiting between events.

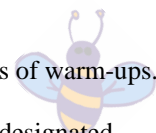

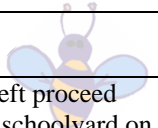

<p><u>Warm-up Procedures:</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warm-ups will be run under New Jersey Swimming Warm-up and Safety Guidelines. • Warm-ups will include general warm-up lanes, sprint lanes, and pace lanes. • All swimmers are entitled to a fair and comparable warm-up. All teams WILL get the same opportunity for general warm-up lanes, sprint lanes, and pace lanes.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All swimmers must enter the pool from the starting end of the pool. New Jersey Swimming officials will monitor warm-ups. All general warm-up lanes will swim in a counterclockwise direction. There will be a one-hour warm-up session with sprint lanes offered in the final 15 minutes of warm-ups. <p>OR - Depending on the number of entries The warm-up sessions will be two 30-minute warm-ups divided by teams. There will be designated sprint lanes/pace lanes during the last 10 minutes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All clubs will be notified by e-mail about these warm-up procedures.
<u>Entry Times:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> New Jersey Swimming does not allow 'NT' or 'No Time' to be used as an entry time. All swimmers must have 1 Silver qualifying time to participate in the session. Each swimmer who has a single Silver qualifying time qualifies to participate in 3 events. All entry times must be in short course yards.
<u>Check-In:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All swimmers will be checked-in by their coaches. Swimmers that are not checked in may be scratched!
<u>Starts:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The host club will determine if 'Fly-over'/'Over-the-top' starts will be used after a time line has been produced. This information will be posted in the pre-meet information.
<u>Distance Events:</u> (500 Free & 400IM)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All 500 yd freestyle and 400 IM events will be run fastest to slowest For all events in Session #2 swimmers must supply timers and for the 500 yd freestyle, the swimmer is responsible for supplying their own counter.
<u>Heat Limited Events</u> <u>Session 2</u>	Session #2 is limited to 1 hour. Teams will be notified within 1 week of the start of the meet of those swimmers who may be scratched due to the 1 hour time line. If necessary, the slowest heat(s) of each event will be scratched. The meet host will consolidate heats to provide the most splash opportunities.
<u>Scoring:</u>	Team Scoring will not be kept.
<u>Awards:</u>	Medals will be awarded for the top 3 swimmers in each individual event.
<u>Entry Fees:</u>	Individual Entry Fee: \$4.00 Make checks payable to: BAYONNE MERMAIDS-STARFISH
<u>Admissions and Programs:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Admission will be \$5.00 per session and Cost of Program will be \$5.00 per session.
<u>Entries:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In accordance with NJS policy, team entries may be submitted by E-mail: to entries1@juno.com All entries must be Hy-Tek program entries as an attached file to an e-mail. The meet entry coordinator will respond to e-mails entries within 48 hours. If you do not receive an e-mail response within 48 hours, assume that your email has not been received. It then becomes the e-mailer's responsibility to make sure that the host club's meet entry coordinator receives the e-mail. If you do not receive an e-mail response, you must contact the entry coordinator by email or phone. An Entry Summary with a signed NJ Swimming waiver and a check must accompany or follow each entry. Accuracy of seed times is essential. Incomplete entries will not be accepted. Deck entries will not be accepted. No phone or faxed entries will be accepted.
<u>Results:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All Teams will receive results via e-mail.
<u>Host Club Responsibilities:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The host club will provide a single timer in each lane through out the meet. The host club will have stopwatches available for volunteers helping to time. The host club will e-mail all club entries back to the participating clubs. The host club will create a warm-up schedule that will be fair and equal to all teams. This warm-up schedule will be e-mailed to all participating clubs no later than 1 week before the meet. The host club will create timing assignments that are fair and equitable with as many teams participating as possible. These timing assignments will be e-mailed to all participating clubs no later than 1 week before the meet.
<u>Participating Club Responsibilities:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participating clubs must help with timing assignments. Timing assignments will be e-mailed to participating clubs 1 week prior to the meet. Participating club parents must stay off the pool deck except for timing assignments. Participating clubs should help with officiating whenever possible. List the club contact for club officials on the meet summary.

<u>Concessions:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Food will be available in the lobby of the school building.
<u>Vendor:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A vendor will be selling swimming items during the meet.
<u>Directions:</u>	N.J. TURNPIKE EXIT 14A (Bayonne) proceed along AVENUE E to East 30th Street. Make left proceed over railroad overpass. Lincoln Community School is on the right. Entrance to pool is through schoolyard on East 30th Street.
