

2008 N.J.I.S.A.A. SWIMMING – BOYS INFORMATION/ELIGIBILITY FORM

RULES:

1. The N.J.I.S.A.A. SWIMMING Championships will be run according to the National Federation rules and regulations.
2. There will be a twenty (20) minute break after the 50 yard Freestyle.
3. **Body paint will not be permitted anywhere on the premises.** Changing areas are available but no place for secure valuables.
4. If a “B” school would like to compete in the “A” Division, the school must request that in writing to the President of the N.J.I.S.A.A. in the beginning of the season.

ENTRIES:

1. Teams may enter up to four swimmers in each individual event and one relay in each relay event.
2. Opposite each contestant’s name on the Official Entry Form list his best time (in yards) under each event entered. PLEASE DO NO REPEAT NAMES.
3. A competitor shall be permitted to enter a maximum of **four (4)** events, no more than **two (2)** of which may be individual events.
4. Team points will be awarded to teams having a regular season schedule. Individuals, without a team, may participate but will receive no points. Team swimmers will bump up when an individual swimmer is ahead of them in that event.
5. **ENTRY DEADLINE – MONDAY, January 28, 2008.** Late entries will not be accepted.
6. Teams will submit their entries electronically using either the Microsoft Excel form available online or using Team Manager, a program available for free from Hy-Tek. Any questions, please call Ellen @ 609-558-0988. Both entry forms are available at:

7. There will be an exhibition 50 yard freestyle, which will count a swimmer’s maximum of 4 events.
8. There will be a scratch meeting at 12:45pm on the day of the meet in the pool office.
9. Please note: Schools may enter their relay teams without individual names listed. It shall not count as an entry unless the competitor actually competes in the event.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Each school’s entry form must bear certification by the Athletic Director that the entrants listed are bona fide students in good standing at the school, meet the school’s rules for athletic eligibility, and meet the eligibility regulations of the State Association. All entry times must be certified by the coach of the school represented.

SPECIAL NOTE

Please note the following rules pertaining to our meet

There will be a twenty (20) minute break AFTER the 50 yard freestyle exhibition event, during which time the pool may be used for warm-up.

Each team coach or school representative must be present at the scratch meeting.

A swimmer may earn points only if he/she is a member of the school team; i.e. the team has an official interscholastic schedule. If the swimmer is not representing a team, he/she will receive an award, BUT NO POINTS. Swimmers beneath him/her will move up one place for their point total.

The fastest three swimmers in each event will receive awards. Points will be awarded for twelve places as follows:

There will be an exhibition 50 yard freestyle event. Coaches will receive a 3 x 5 cards at the scratch meeting for their entries in this event.

There will be an official on each lane to record back-up times. In case of a malfunction of the automatic timing device, the official's hand time will be considered official.

There should be no glass containers in the swimming pool area and no shaving in the shower.

No paint will be allowed on swimmers or their suits.
