

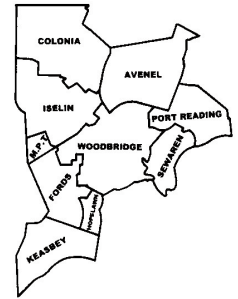

General Information:

All events are at Woodbridge Community Center and surrounding areas.

Eligibility:

New Jersey residents and out-of-state athletes who are age 50 and over (age as of September 1, 2008.)

Competitive Categories:

There are male and female competition groups in all events. The age divisions are: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, & 90+.

Equipment:

All participants must supply their own equipment unless otherwise specified in event description.

Registration/Deadline:

All entries must be received by August 8, 2008.

Athletes may enter as many events as they like but it is the athlete's responsibility to enter events that do not overlap in time. **It is not the responsibility of the New Jersey Senior Olympics to wait for athletes who are late for their competition. Participants must check in at the Registration Area** sometime throughout the weekend.

Rain:

In the event of rain, all events will proceed as scheduled, unless it becomes necessary to move or cancel them.

Please Note: NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY BE TRANSPORTED INTO THE COMMUNITY CENTER OR ANY OTHER VENUE.

Awards:

Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded in each age/sex category.

Costs:

Some events have fees additional to the general registration fee of \$25.00. Your initial registration fee covers entry to three (3) events.

General Registration:

\$25.00 (For three (3) events)

Special Events: (No general registration fee required) Each additional event: \$10.00 (after first three (3) events.)

Golf: \$60.00 (includes cart)

Softball Team Entry: \$150.00

If participants of Golf or Softball Teams wish to enter any other event, they must pay the \$25.00 general registration fee.

Archery:

Recurve and compound division. Both divisions shoot a single 900 round on September 21, 2008 at Brookdale Park in Bloomfield. 10 am Start.

Basketball:

Balls are provided for all Basketball events.

Basketball Accuracy Shooting:

Most baskets made from (5) specified locations.

Basketball Foul Shooting:

Best of 20 free throw shots.

Three-on-Three Basketball:

Half court competition, NCAA tournament rules. Two periods of 10 minutes running time divided by 5-minute intermission. **ENTER AS TEAMS ONLY. NO INDIVIDUAL APPLICATION WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Uniforms with numbers required. Single sex teams with max 9 members. Age divisions will be determined by the age of the youngest member. Send all applications together with a team roster and name of team representative. **NO ROSTER CHANGES AFTER September 1, 2008.** Woodbridge Community Center.

Billiards:

An eight ball tournament will be held in each age/sex division. Tournament directors may combine divisions if necessary. Personal use sticks must be used. Tournament will follow Woodbridge Senior Club rules. For a set of rules, contact Chester Kinal at 732-738-7389. Woodbridge Community Center.

Bocce:

Teams can consist of singles & doubles only and play to 12 points. Competition in each age/sex division. Equipment provided. Warren Park.

Bowling:

Woodbridge Bowling Center, 346 Main Street, Woodbridge. Squads are on **Friday, September 12, at 10 am and Saturday, September 13, at 2 and 6 pm.** An entrant may bowl once in singles and unlimited times in doubles for which eligible with a different partner. In doubles the age classification is that of the youngest partner. Contestants entered in any bowling event may make on site entries in additional bowling events. All bowlers must pay a \$6.00 lineage fee prior to each squad in which participating. **On Line 1** of Special Remarks list day and time requested for singles. **On Line 2** list day and time requested for doubles plus name of partner. Since the tournament is sanctioned by the by the American Bowling Congress and the Women's International Bowling Congress, each con-

testant must present a 2008-2009 membership card or a 2008-2009 receipt. Bowlers lacking a sanctioned card or receipt must pay one of the following fees: USBC Affiliate Membership, \$16.00, USBC Participation fee, \$5.00. An affiliate membership gives the bowler full membership privileges in the USBC for the 2007-2008 season plus membership in the local association where the bowler resides. A participation fee entitles the entrant to compete in the tournament but does not entitle the bowler to any USBC awards. Bowlers under the age of 55 on **Sept. 1, 2008** are not eligible for USBC Senior Awards.

Cycling:

One kilometer to 10-kilometer criterium event on flat paved course. IT IS MANDATORY FOR PARTICIPANTS TO WEAR HELMETS. Location: Woodbridge Center Mall, start near Fortunoff.

Darts:

Players will play baseball, nine innings, single elimination tournament. Woodbridge CC.

Horseshoes:

Single elimination each age/sex division tournament. Location: Warren Park.

Racquetball:

Doubles & Singles competition. A single tournament will be held in each age/sex division. Location: Club at Woodbridge. IT IS MANDATORY FOR PARTICIPANTS TO WEAR PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR.

Swimming:

25-yard pool. Diving starts permissible. Bathing cap required. Four (4) events per day limit. *Please contact Ellen Mace at 609-558-0988 for a swimming application. See application on page 23 for day to day schedule of events. Location: Woodbridge Community Center.

Table Tennis:

Singles, doubles and mixed doubles. Participants may only enter 2 out of the 3 events offered. Age divisions for doubles and mixed doubles will be determined by the age of the youngest player.

Tennis:

Singles, doubles and mixed doubles. Participants may only enter 2 out of the 3 events offered. Age divisions for doubles and mixed doubles will be determined by the age of the youngest player. Preliminary rounds of eight (8) game pro-set, no-ad scoring. Finals are best of three sets, with regular scoring (or at discretion of tournament director).

List doubles partners in Special Remarks section of the application. Participants must supply a new can of tennis balls for each game. Participants must have a partner for doubles/mixed doubles.

List your mixed doubles partner's name in the Special Remarks section of the application.

The deadline for Tennis is 8/8/2008.

This is a firm deadline. We will call you with starting times after September 1.

Golf:

Low score wins. Foursomes will be assigned. Golfers must supply clubs. Golf carts must be used. Cost of \$60 includes cart. All ages will play at Shark River Golf Course, Neptune, NJ, on October 8, 2008. (Registration for golf is on a first come first serve basis. Max : 100 players.)

Softball:

Team Competition Saturday/Sunday. Captains will be called with tournament draws after Sept. 1. Tournament will be held in the following age division: 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+. ENTER AS TEAMS ONLY. NO INDIVIDUAL APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Seven inning games. Single sex teams with max of 18 players. Age division will be determined by the age of the youngest team member.
